POSITION: Part-Time Firefighter/Paramedic or EMT; FLSA non-exempt

HOURLY WAGE: \$9.25 to \$13.00, Depending on Experience and Level of Certifications

To apply, candidates must complete and submit the complete Employment Application Packet and Resume to Battalion Chief Rich Solomon, a copy of which may be obtained from the District's website at www.sablealturafire.org, by email at admin@sablealturafire.org, or by calling the District's Headquarters at (303) 364-7187.

Completed Employment Applications must be received by the Application Deadline in the District offices at SAFD Headquarters 26900 E. Colfax Ave. #52, Aurora, Colorado, 80018.

Applications received after that date and time will not be considered.

SUMMARY OF POSITION: The District has established a Part-Time Firefighter/Paramedic and EMT Program. The District is hiring one qualified individual to work regularly scheduled shifts as a Part-Time Firefighter/EMT. Regardless whether they are working regularly scheduled shifts or are on the Will-Call List, all Part-Time Firefighter/Paramedic's or EMT's are subject to District's emergency services, operational and business needs and are not guaranteed any work in a given work period. Part-Time Firefighter/Paramedic's or EMT's are not eligible to receive any fringe benefits other than participating in the Colorado Statewide Money Purchase Plan administered by the Fire and Police Pension Association (FPPA), and workers' compensation and unemployment compensation insurance.

DISTRICT OVERVIEW: The District is a combination fire and emergency services organization protecting 26 square miles of private, commercial, and agricultural property. Calls consist of 85% medical, 10% fire and rescue, and 5% miscellaneous. In addition to the Fire Chief, there currently is a full-time Battalion Chief, a full-time Captain, and approximately 35 volunteer firefighters. The District's services include, but are not limited to: emergency medical, ambulance, structure fires, wildland fires, vehicle fires, hazardous material spills, motor vehicle accidents, confined space rescue, water and ice rescue, search and rescue, fire prevention, and public education.

The District has the right not to hire any of the applicants for the position, or to terminate the hiring process at any time, in its sole discretion. Candidates are solely responsible for all costs incurred in connection with the application and selection process. Qualified individuals with disabilities may request reasonable accommodation for an examination at least three business days before the examination.
